RULES

1. This is a BTBA sanctioned tournament and the general playing & tournament rules of the BTBA shall govern this event, together with the following special rules:
2. The Tournament is open to all members of the BTBA. All bowlers unable to show proof of current membership may enter upon payment of £1 at registration. Non members are not eligible for BTBA services and will not receive ranking points.
3. Competitors should be members of The Original Bowling Company Senior Bowlers Club. Nonmembers may enter upon payment of £5 for day membership.
4. Dress code prohibits the wearing of jeans, denim shirts, singlet vests, shorts or cycling shorts.
5. To qualify for this event, bowlers must be aged at least 50 on or before the day of the tournament. Bowlers will receive an age bonus of 1 point per every 2 years over 50 plus 50% difference between their entering average (based on last 5 senior tournament results) and 210 (200 for ladies)
6. The Tournament Manager will be Ian Carling, who reserves the right to reject any entry and to decide upon any point not covered in the above rules.
7. Closing date for entries will be 10th April 2011.
8. A provisional ball shall be rolled in the case of a dispute relating to pinfall which cannot be resolved on the spot. Protests must be lodged with the tournament manager within 30 minutes of the game in question and confirmed in writing within 72 hours. The tournament manager's decision shall be final, subject to an appeal to the BTBA.
9. In the event of a tie for any of the 'cut' positions, the bowler with the highest last game (including bonuses) shall be awarded the place. Should this result in a further tie, then the penultimate game shall decide and so on. If there are any ties for cash places, the prize money will be shared equally among the competitors involved. However, if there is a tie for first place overall, a one game rolloff shall be bowled.
10. Entry fees will be non-refundable after squad times have been accepted. All fees must be enclosed with the entry forms. Squadding is allocated on a first come, first served basis but the Sunday afternoon squad is only available to bowlers with over 80 miles to travel. Telephone bookings will only be accepted with a credit/debit card. A minimum deposit of £10 is required.
11. All bowlers must register at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time.
12. The entry fee will be £37.00. This includes £10.00 prize fund (returned 100%), contribution to Team England (20p), lineage, expenses and Masters prize fund.
13. Bowlers must be a full member of the Senior Bowlers Club and have bowled in at least five out of ten events to be eligible to qualify for the Masters.
14. TOBC order of Merit points will be awarded based on final positions as follows:
 - Men – 1st 50 points, 2nd 49 points, 3rd 48 points etc.....50th 1 point.
 - Women – 1st 25 points, 2nd 24 points, 3rd 23 points etc.....25th 1 point.
